OBJECTIVES

This workshop has been designed to provide participants with an in-depth understanding of the Occupational Safety & Health Act of 2007 and the Fire Risk Reduction Rules, Legal Notice No. 59 and its requirements as well as the principles and skills necessary for the effective planning and conduct of safety audits of a workplace. Participants will learn how to prepare reports on audit findings, follow up on audit findings and also identify areas for improvement. A significant part of the training will focus on hands-on practice in auditing to reinforce concepts discussed.
